he Push AFO's unique design enables it to perform several functions. The relatively supple sole leaves dorsal flexion in the ankle joint free and enables the (residual) function of the calf muscles during push-off to contribute to an efficient and natural gait pattern. At heel strike it has a restraining function on the plantar flexion of the foot, and at stance phase it gives bilateral support to the ankle joint. -E.P.F. Janssen, MD
